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Land of Peace Pilgrimages – 11 Day Holy Land Pilgrimage

DAY 1: Tuesday 21- Sept. Depart USA – Tel-Aviv

Today: Depart for Tel Aviv with complimentary meals and beverages served onboard your international flight.

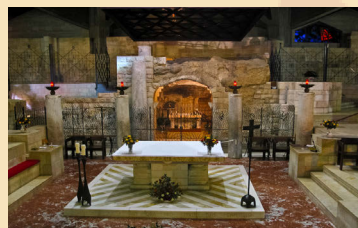
DAY 2: Wednesday 22 - Sept. ARRIVE TEL AVIV

Today: Upon arrival in Tel Aviv, we will meet our guide and bus driver at the airport.
Evening: Proceed to our hotel in Nazareth.



DAY 3: Thursday 23 Sept. - Tabor - Cana - Nazareth

Today: Drive to Mount Tabor, the site of the Transfiguration, and then to Cana of Galilee to visit the Wedding Church, where Jesus performed the first of his signs, changing water to wine. We will have Mass with renewal of marital promises for couples. Afterwards, we will drive to Nazareth and visit the Basilica of the Annunciation and the grotto where Archangel Gabriel visited Mary. Then we will proceed to the house of the Holy Family underneath the Church of St. Joseph.
We will end our day with an audience with Vicar of Nazareth, Fr. Hanna Kildani.
Evening: Dinner at your hotel in Nazareth.



DAY 4: Friday 24 Sept. - Tiberias - Sea of Galilee- Capernaum– Mt. of Beatitudes

Today: After breakfast we drive to the Sea of Galilee (40 min) to visit the Mt. of Beatitudes where our Lord gave the Sermon on the Mount and celebrate Mass upon arrival. A short bus ride brings us to the Mount of Tabgha to see the splendid mosaic of the loaves and fishes, where Jesus fed the crowd of 5,000 people with five loaves of bread and two fish. Also, in Tabgha we will visit the Church of St. Peter's Primacy where Jesus gave the keys to the kingdom to Peter. We continue to Capernaum to see the house of St. Peter and the synagogue where our Lord preached. For lunch, you will have an opportunity to try the St. Peter's fish. The day concludes with a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee and a visit to see the "Jesus Boat," a 2000-year-old boat found on the shores of Magdala. We visit Magdala and the archeological park. We drive back to Nazareth (40 min).
Evening: Dinner at your hotel in Nazareth.



DAY 5: Saturday 25 Sept. - Caesarea - Haifa

Today: We drive to Caesarea Maritime (45 min), where St. Peter baptized Cornelius and St. Paul and where St. Paul was a prisoner. Here we visit the Roman aqueducts and theater and the palace of Pontius Pilate. Then we drive (30 min) to Haifa and ascend to Mt. Carmel where the Carmelite Order began 900 years ago. We celebrate Mass at the Church of Stella Maris, "The Star of the Sea." The monastery is located above the cave where the prophet Elijah once lived. We will visit the beautiful Baha'i Gardens that provide a panoramic view of the city. After lunch in Haifa we return to Nazareth (40 min).



Dinner: Dinner at your hotel in Nazareth.

DAY 6: Sunday 26 Sept. – Jericho - Jacobs' Well (Nablus)

Today: After breakfast, we drive south along the Jordan Valley to Kasr El-Yahud, Jesus' baptismal site on the river Jordan. We drive to Samaria to visit Jacob's Well that



lies in a crypt of a modern Greek Orthodox church in Nablus. We continue to the oldest inhabited city in the world, Jericho. While in Jericho, we view the Mount of Temptation, where the devil tempted Jesus during his forty-day fast.
Evening: Dinner at your hotel in Jericho.

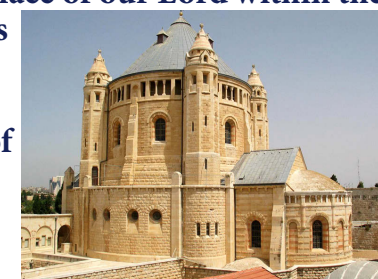
DAY 7 Monday 27 Sept. - Dead Sea - Bethany

Today: We will travel to Qumran (70 min), a 2,000-year-old site where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Time and weather permitting, we will have the opportunity to float on the Dead Sea, the lowest and saltiest spot on Earth. We will continue through the Judean wilderness to Bethany, the site where Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead.
Evening: Dinner at your hotel in Jerusalem.



DAY 8: Tuesday 28 Sept.- Bethlehem – Ein-Karem

Today: We drive to Bethlehem where we visit the Grotto of the Nativity, the birth place of our Lord within the Basilica of the Nativity. We will also visit the Church of St. Catherine and the Caves of St. Joseph and St. Jerome. After a short bus ride, we arrive at the Shepherds' Fields, where the Angels appeared to the shepherds announcing the birth of Jesus. After lunch we head to the village of Ein – Karem (20 min) to visit the birth place of St. John the Baptist and the Church of the Visitation where Mary came to visit her kinswoman Elizabeth and proclaimed the Magnificat.
Evening: Dinner your hotel in Jerusalem.



DAY 9 Wednesday 29 Sept. - Jerusalem - The Passion of Jesus' last hours

Today: Before breakfast, we attend Mass at the Church of Holy Sepulcher, then return to our hotel. After eating, we head to the Old City to visit the Western Wall, Dome of the Rock and El-Aqsa Mosque. We then walk to St. Anne's Church, the Pools of Bethesda, and the Judgment Hall where Jesus was condemned to death by Pontius Pilate. At this point, we begin walking the Via Dolorosa through the markets of the Old City while praying the Stations of the Cross, stopping at each of the fourteen stations until we reach the Church of Holy Sepulcher. Here, we venerate Calvary and the empty Tomb of our Lord. The day ends with an audience with the Latin Patriarch.
Evening: Dinner at your hotel in Jerusalem.



DAY 10: Thursday 30 Sept.- Jerusalem Mt. Of Olives – Mt. Zion

Today: We drive to the top of the Mount of Olives for a panoramic view of Jerusalem and then continue on to the Church of Pater Noster where Jesus taught his disciples how to pray. We then walk the route of Palm Sunday to the Church of Dominus Flevit, where our Lord wept over the city, and then to the Garden of Gethsemane and the neighboring church where Jesus uttered his last prayer at the Rock of Agony. This afternoon, we visit Mount Zion and the Church of the Dormition commemorating our Blessed Mother falling asleep. Next, we visit the Cenacle (the Upper Room), the place of the Last Supper and Pentecost.
Lastly, we visit the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu, and the house of the high-priest Caiaphas where Jesus was imprisoned and where Peter denied our Lord.
Evening: overnight at your hotel in Jerusalem.



DAY 11: Friday 1 Oct RETURN USA

Today: Depends on the time of departure, we visit Emaus and continue drive to Tel-Aviv airport (45 min) to board our return flight to the USA.
